
- Seven darlingtons per package
- Output current 500mA per driver (600mA peak)
- Output voltage 50V
- Integrated suppression diodes for inductive loads
- Outputs can be paralleled for higher current
- TTL/CMOS/PMOS/DTL Compatible inputs
- Inputs pinned opposite outputs to simplify layout



The ULN2001, ULN2002, ULN2003 and ULN 2004 are high voltage, high current darlington arrays each containing seven open collector darlington pairs with common emitters. Each channel rated at 500mA and can withstand peak currents of 600mA. Suppression diodes are included for inductive load driving and the inputs are pinned opposite the outputs to simplify board layout.

The versions interface to all common logic families:

ULN2001	General Purpose, DTL, TTL, PMOS, CMOS
ULN2002	14-25V PMOS
ULN2003	5V TTL, CMOS
ULN2004	6-15V CMOS, PMOS



These versatile devices are useful for driving a wide range of loads including solenoids, relays DC motors, LED displays filament lamps, thermal printheads and high power buffers.

The ULN2001A/2002A/2003A and 2004A are supplied in 16 pin plastic DIP packages with a copper leadframe to reduce thermal resistance. They are available also in small outline package (SO-16) as ULN2001D1/2002D1/2003D1/2004D1.




Figure 1. Schematic diagram













Figure 11. Collector current vs input current Figure 12. Collector current vs saturation voltage





Figure 13. Peak collector current vs duty cycle Figure 14. Peak collector current vs duty cycle




6 Package mechanical data


